Duties and Responsibilities: Remember Who is the basis of your life and has planned for your greatest growth and well-being, whether you like it or not. Your life is Him in disguise. From a few Weekly Retreats ago, handling life is best done through the Four Filters – surrender, faith, patience and acceptance i.e. “God grant me serenity to accept the things I cannot change, the courage to change the things I can change, and the wisdom to know the difference.”
